Mount Ambae

You may have heard something about the volcano on Ambae. Ambae is 25kms off the East coast of Santo. The whole island is a volcano which was dormant for over 100 years but began erupting last week. The current eruption is dangerous due to the presence of two lakes (Manaro and Vui) in the crater. If the water from the lakes meets the lava, this could cause an enormous explosion. This would have serious consequences for Ambae and nearby areas.
